All the students belonging to Minority Community (Muslim, Sikh, Buddhist, Christian, Parsi and Jain) are hereby informed that online applications are invited for Scholarship Scheme for Minority students (Government of Maharashtra Scholarship) in the academic year 2021-22 through the website [www.mahadbtmahait.gov.in](http://www.mahadbtmahait.gov.in). The students who wish to get the benefit of this scheme will have to carefully fill the online application form through mahadbtmahait portal & sent to email: [scholarship@git-india.edu.in](mailto:scholarship@git-india.edu.in) upto 31<sup>st</sup> January 2022.

Benefit: - Rs.25, 000/- for a year

Eligibility:

1. Income certificate below Rs.8 Lakh (of Financial Year 2020-21)
2. Applicant passed SSC exam from Maharashtra state.
3. Applicant having Domicile Certificate of Maharashtra state.
4. Applicant admitted through CAP/IL

Process:

1. Through mahadbtmahait portal, applicants register themselves with OTP sent to aadhar linked registered mobile number
2. Applicants have to fill complete profile.
3. From All Scheme menu, select department name as Minority Development Department and scheme as Scholarship for students of minority communities pursuing Higher and Professional courses (DTE)
4. Finally submit the application.

- 12 Income Minority declaration
- 13 GAP affidavit if GAP after qualifying exam
- 14 Scheme related Undertaking Certificate

**Note: The students are eligible to apply for only one scheme in a year. Student should choose EBC/SC scholarship or Minority scholarship.**
