- 1. To create awareness about the importance of innovation for economic and societal progress.
- 2. To develop a culture of innovation, creativity and entrepreneurship among students, faculty, and staff within the institution.
- 3. To organize events, competitions, and initiatives that celebrates innovation.
- 4. To generate innovative ideas across various domains, such as technology, social impact, healthcare, and sustainability.
- 5. To provide resources, mentorship and networking opportunities for budding entrepreneurs.
- 6. To design short term courses, workshops, and experiential learning opportunities that equip students with the skills and knowledge needed to succeed as entrepreneurs.
- 7. To build and maintain relationships with industry partners, investors, and other stakeholders to create opportunities for collaboration and mentorship for start-ups.
- 8. To involve students in joint research projects, technology transfer agreements, and industry-sponsored initiatives.
- 9. To commercialize innovations developed within the institution.
- 10. To keep track on the progress of start-ups and identify the areas for improvement.
- 11. To develop distributed maker's Lab in the institute.
- 12. To create awareness amongst students about the various resources available in GIT for innovation and incubation.
- 13. To develop network with other incubation centers.
- 14. To develop think tank, problem bank, idea bank to foster innovation.
- 15. To develop wall, display posters that promote innovation amongst students, faculty and staff of GIT.
- 16. To identify alumni, resources, and experts and leverage them for startup development.
- 17. To collaborate with Sustainability cell of GIT.
