After the decline of covid pandemic, this was the first student's event at GITCollege. The event was open for Engineering, Diploma and all undergraduate level students. Due to the covid restrictions and by understanding the latest trend of digital era, the event was arranged in hybrid mode (Both online and Offline) for the very first time. This Technical festival was sponsored by GCL, Central Bank of India, Khed and Bank of India, Khed. Participants from 30 institutes were participated in this festival in various events.

The flyer and brochure was out on 16th March,2022 and the registrations were started just scanning the QR code. The registrations forms were sent to more than 1000 different colleges using e-media. After the registrations were over, submissions were invited from the participants in the form of images/PDFs/Videos. All the registered participants were kept informed time to time about the updates of the events. Submissions were done till 24th March, 2022.
